

## Important Information Regarding September 1, 2010 Deadline for Surplus Lines Producer Affidavits

The September 1<sup>st</sup> deadline for late filing fees of \$25.00 has gone into place for filing affidavits with the Pennsylvania Surplus Lines Association.

The increasing number of missing producer affidavits (160-PR) led to the decision to charge a \$25.00 fee that cannot be charged back to the client, whenever the affidavit is not provided within the 45 days set by law.

Affidavits must be filed with the Pennsylvania Surplus Lines Association within 45 days of the policy's effective date. Affidavits must be complete and correct before they are accepted and assigned a date of receipt by the PSLA. If these forms are received after the required date, a late filing fee will be imposed of \$25.00.

Failure to comply could result in much higher fines imposed by the Insurance Department.
